PLEASE READ CAREFULLY AND PROVIDE THE FOLLOWING:

CREW CATERING LOAD IN:

Small election of fresh bread rolls, with small assorted deli tray with i.e. tuna, salmon, roast beef, ham, turkey, cheese

1 can of strong, Freshley brewed coffee , Starbucks espresso preferred (NO INSTANT COFFEE please)

sugar & cream

1 pot of tea

6 cans of coke, 6 cans of coke light

DINNER

BUYOUT of 15 pounds per person (band and crew).

If management is traveling with band, they also should recieve a buyout/meal

Due to the fact that the band do not souncheck and are therefore not at the venue until 45 min before showtime, band and crew eat their hot meal early in the afternoon, whilst traveling. They will have travelled some distance and usually rest around venue dinner times. The crew is usually to busy to eat at normal venue dinner times. This is why we choose a buy-out above a sit down meal.

BAND CATERING DRESSING ROOM

Two hours prior to performance

24 x small bottles of non carbonated water
1 hot water kettle with English Breakfast tea (PG Tips, Typhoo or Tetleys)
Milk and Sugar
6 cans of Coca Cola/Pepsi and 6 cans Coke Light/ Pepsi Light
1 pint of fresh orange juice
2 liter bottles of 'San Pellegrino' mineral water
8 x cans of smoothflow bitter (Boddingtons)
2 bottles of Californian RED wine

Selection of fresh bread/rolls (whole wheat)
Selection of 'deli style' tuna, salmon, roast beef, ham, turkey, cheese (ample for 6 people) We like to make our own sandwiches/rolls!
Small jar of Mustard, Hellmans Mayonaise and Branston Pickle
A small selection of fresh fruit (especially bananas, apples, oranges)
1 small plate of assorted FRESH anti pasta (olives, sundried tomatoes etc)
1 small plate of fresh italian plum tomatoes, onions, bell pepper, hot red pepper and lemons
1 plate of assorted sausage rolls/pork pies
1 bag of assorted Cadbury's chocolates
1 bag of Tortilla Chips with hot salsa
Ice, glasses, cups and all other necessary cutlery (knives, forks, spoons)
6 large towels. No bar towels please!
If no refrigerator available, one large case of ice
For Stage: 12 small bottles non carb water plus 6 small clean towels

Near End of performance:

1 large plate of **assorted hot snacks** (for 6 people)
10 small bottles of non carbonated water
(ask tourmanager if necessary)

PLEASE NOTE: Often ignored, the food and drink rider is a very important part of the contract. The band is on tour for months and travelling is intense. Travel times on a good day can be 5-7 hours at the least. A healthy, fresh and assorted diet is important in keeping band and crew in good shape, ensuring that when we come to your town we can put on the best show possible. Thank you.
